

# WHAT MUST I DO TO BE SAVED?

**Acts 16:25-34**

**Introduction:** This is the most important question you will ever answer.

**Background:** Why do you think the Philippian jailer asked?

1. God uses your **life** to provide opportunities to **share** the gospel (Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God), **16:25-30**
  - Circumstances – you are where you are for a reason
  - Opportunities – you are where you are as His representative
  
2. God uses your **words** to provide opportunities to **receive** the gospel (Paul and Silas were eager and available to witness for God), **16:31-32**
  - The only way to be saved
  - The impact on others when you are saved
  - The book about being saved
  
3. God uses your **obedience** to provide opportunities to **enjoy** the gospel (The jailer and his family were ready and willing to take the next steps with God), **16:33-34**
  - **Serving** others because of God
  - **Telling** others out of love for God
  - **Rejoicing** with others in God
